Festive Season Greetings!

As my tenure as Chair of ISPO UK MS comes to a close, I have no doubt handing over to John Sullivan and a strong Executive Team will undoubtedly progress the ISPO UK Member Society to fulfil its aim of delivering a unified, harmonious, high standard of care across the country. Treatment of the disabled, based on evidence of outcome measures is now a common goal. Two fundamental yardsticks to measure comfort and confidence is the norm. Reduction in the risk of falls, reduced risk of tissue injury and low back pain and long-term avoidance of osteoarthritis are simple outcomes all Multi-Disciplinary Team certified practitioners are using to assess their activities.

Globally this is now the dominant narrative in O&P, from the recent US Act of Senate enshrining this in law to the European Medical Devices rule making having a Quality Management System in every care facility as mandatory. So, the framework is set, that we all have to follow standard procedures to remain within the law and discharge our duties based on processes which have patients' needs at its centre.

The MDT's education how to conduct research, how to extract real outcome from peer reviewed disseminations, the status of science in Direct Skeletal Fixation and Socket Technology and the need for Big Data in Open Source and Open Access is now set as the key priority for ISPO International, the US AOPA and Academy. Indeed, these needs are now the backbone of streams of collaborations across the globe with all organisations in the P&O sphere sharing information with increasing respect for all.

The next chapter is enabling access to gold standard of care using knowledge and technology to train the new generation of MDT practitioners. Understanding best practice needs communication and raising skills, which goes beyond conventional national boundaries. The countries around the North Sea have pledged to work for this aim in the coming four years. With joint scientific meetings planned for 2021 and 2022, we need to ensure facilities for participation through travel bursaries and wider on-line access to manage climate challenges of travel. The Executive Team, balanced with industry and clinical participants, share the view of leaving a more sustainable future for the next generation.

Integration of International Standards' activity with ISPO Education and Training will describe the method and map of this journey towards rehabilitation of disabled patients, improving their wellbeing, and enhancing their lives. This is their innate right and working towards that is the most rewarding activity for our ISPO family and colleagues on this inspiring journey.

The 17th World Congress of ISPO was held in Kobe, Japan from 5-8 October 2019 under the guiding theme "Basics to Bionics".



4,400 participants from 97 countries attended the event alongside 154 exhibitors from 38 countries. The programme comprised 5 keynote presentations, 24 symposia, 28 instructional courses, 348 free paper presentations and 129 poster presentations.

ISPO UK MS awarded FIVE travel bursaries to UK members to support their attendance at the Congress.
